Results of the joint working

Site finding

- **Jointly work with Parish Councils.**
- **UDC has large number of completed Rural exception schemes.**
- **Wimbish – Needed access to field, used UDC garage site, was re-provided**
- **First ever delivery of Rural Passivhaus scheme in England**

Assessing housing need

- **Jointly work with Housing Enabler.**
- **Both work with Parish Councils**
- **Identified scheme based on local need**
- **Jointly approach planners at early stage**
- **Check register reflects need**
- **Update ward councillor**

Jointly making schemes work

- **Turning Local Communities desire into real schemes**
- **Early consultation**
- **Trust – open book (open market homes)**
- **Identifying resource shortfall**
- **Jointly attracted Government growth area funding - enabled higher levels of energy efficiency – Hatfield Heath**
