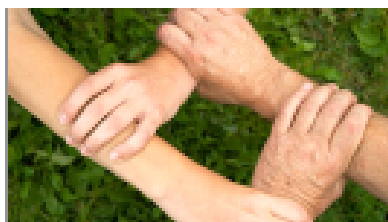

### Galaxy Hot Chocolate Fund

Food manufacturer MARS Incorporated is providing the Galaxy Hot Chocolate Fund as part of its commitment to addressing health and wellness issues and promoting healthy lifestyles. In the last six years, the Fund has helped more than 100,000 people.

The Fund aims to provide small, one-off grants for individuals and community groups whose projects focus on sporting and leisure activities and community improvement.

**\*Grants Manual of Guidance\***

The Grants Manual of Guidance has now been approved by Cabinet. The Manual helps give your staff an information about the specific type of grant funding they are administering. There are a range of templates that you may need to use in the process.

The Manual sets out how the types of grants should be administered by members of staff involved in the management of grant funding.

To support implementation of the Policy, the Council has developed the Bidlink and Fundlink systems, through which all grant related activity now needs to be recorded and managed.

Mandatory use of these systems will ensure that the Council achieves accurate records of all grant funding it is involved in.

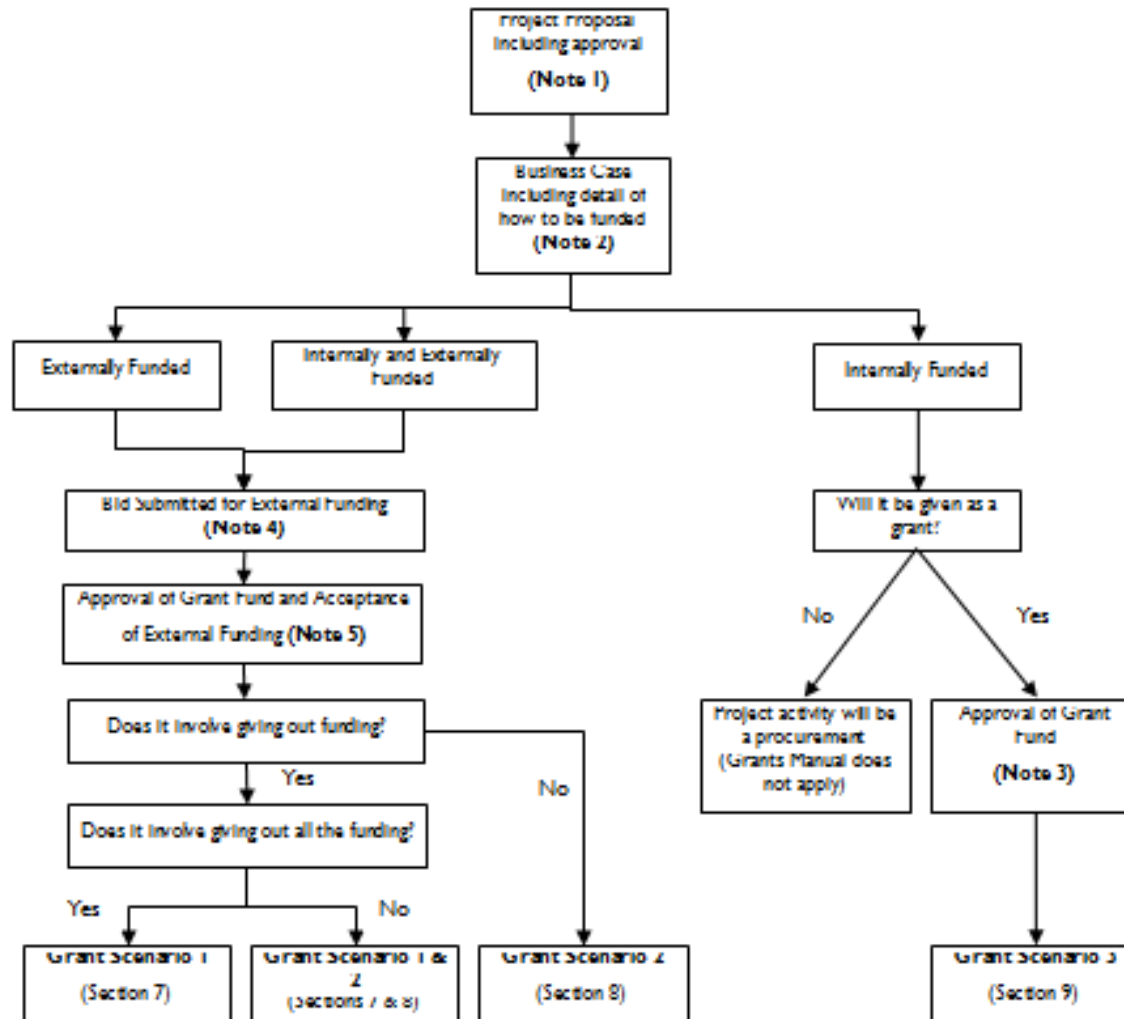
