APPRAISER'S REVIEW

- 15 completed / 5 in process across 5 LAGs
- Need to get under the skin of the application. Not just process
- · Those appraised to date have been principally land-based/SME/farming, being:-
- Glamping
- Adding value
- Forestry
- Dairy farming
- Harvesting equipment
- Tine drill for seed
- Herb processing
- Self-storage



CONCLUSIONS

- Small farms (10-90 ha)
- Passion: developing business
- Grant framework challenging
- Agents a mixed blessing
- Few applicants have real business plans
- Difficulty in addressing employment & growth
- LACK OF BUSINESS PLANNING DISCIPLINE

- RPA: compliance focused
- Missing: animation, facilitation, training
- How will EARDF emerge from Treasury/DEFRA?
