

A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets – The English Indices of Deprivation 2010, Local Authority District Summaries

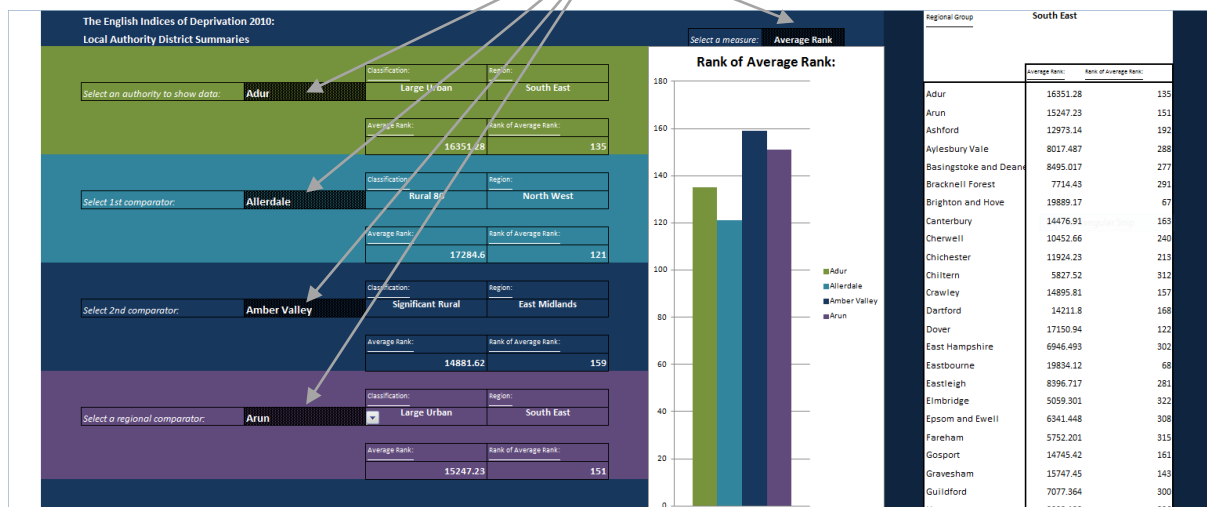
The attached spreadsheet presents information on the relative levels of deprivation in England.

The spreadsheet allows the user to select three local authorities of interest plus an authority from the same region as the first selected authority, it also allows the user to select the measure of interest. The spreadsheet then presents the associated deprivation information for the selected authorities, as well as the data relating to the regional and rural classification groupings for the primary authority selected.

All data comes from statistics released by the Department for Communities and Local Government.

To make your selections from the analysis, please follow these instructions:

There are five cells in which selections can be made.



Clicking on any of these cells, and then on the grey square that appears when a cell is selected provides the full list of options to choose from.



The deprivation measure value and its ranked position for each selected authority appear here.

The ranked positions populate the bar chart here to show the relative position between the selected authorities.

The region and the rural/urban classification of the primary selected authority then populate the lists with the deprivation ranking for the appropriate groupings.
