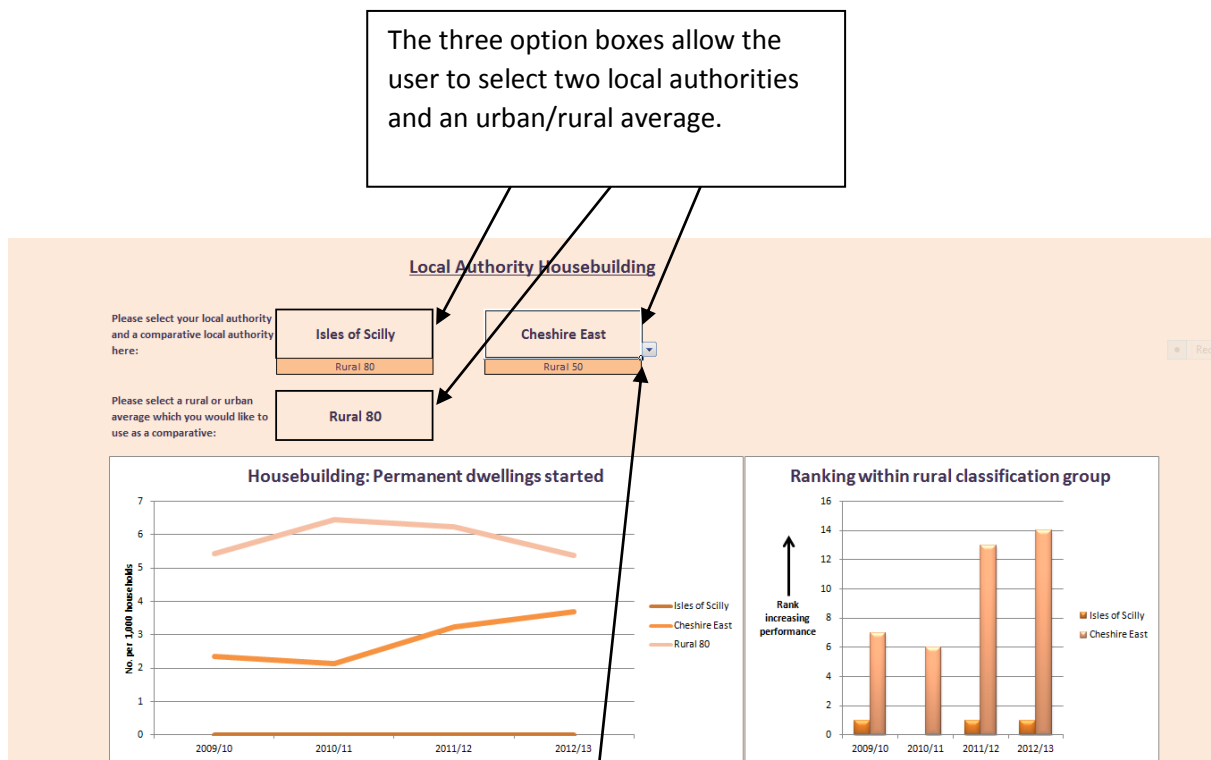


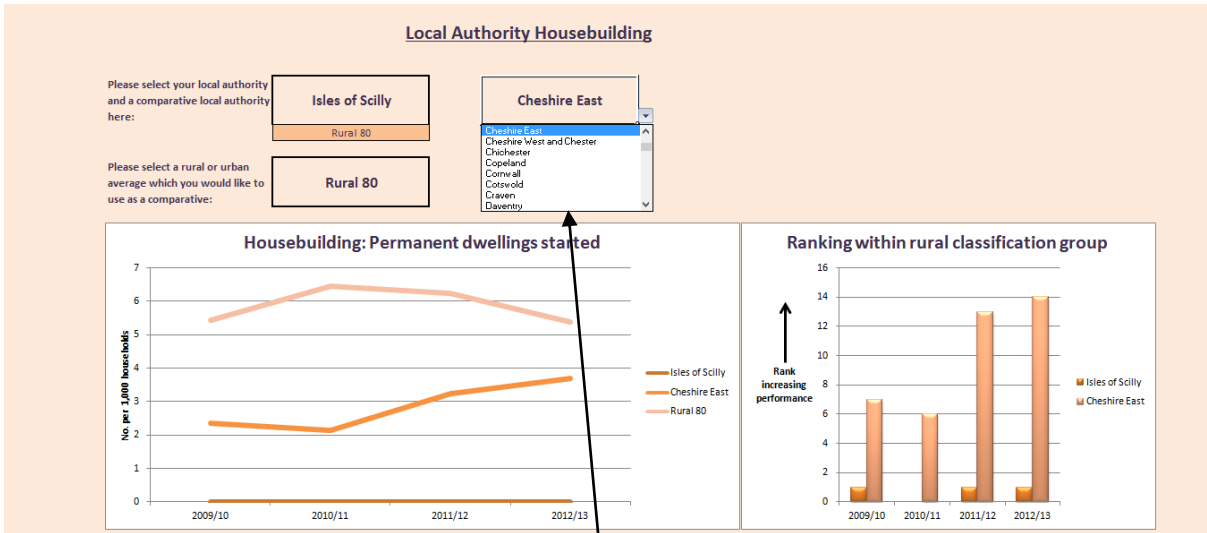
A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets - Local Authority House Building

Housing supply is a constant issue of concern for both policy makers and for those wishing to join the property market. With this in mind, the following analysis takes a look at the house building statistics showing the number of permanent dwellings started and the number of dwellings completed.

To use the analysis, please follow these simple steps.



Using the mouse to select one of the options reveals a grey square with a blue triangle to the right of the option.



Clicking on the grey square then reveals the full list of options to select from.

The first analysis looks at the dwellings started, the second looks at the numbers behind dwellings completed. All values are given per 1,000 households for that local authority area.

Against each of these line charts are bar graphs demonstrating the relative ranking within the relevant rural classification for the selected local authority.
