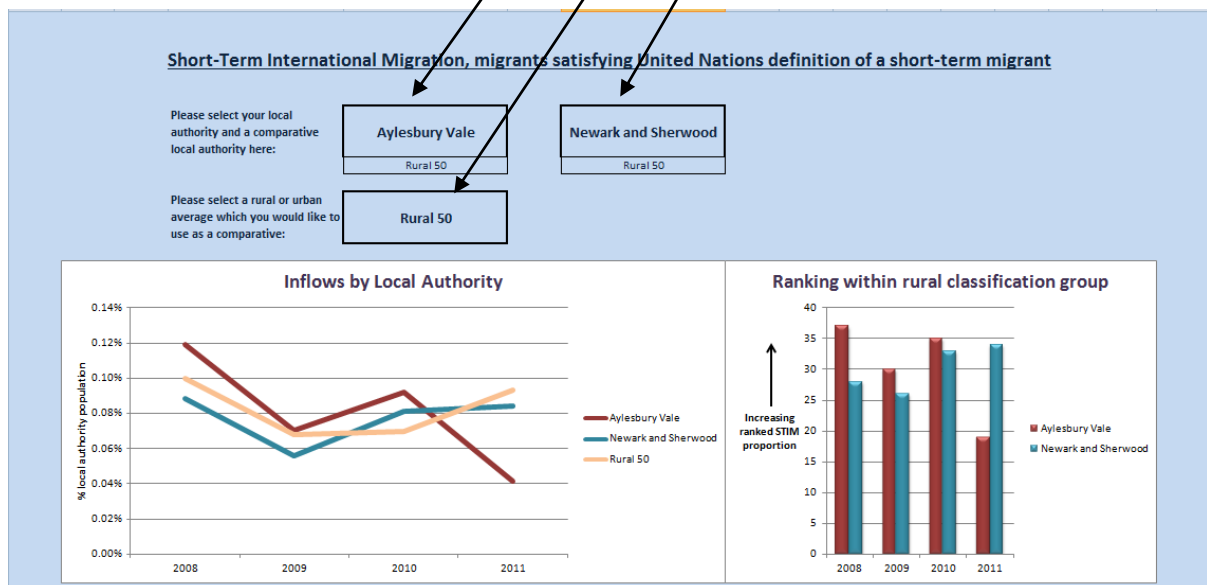


## A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets - Short-Term International Migration

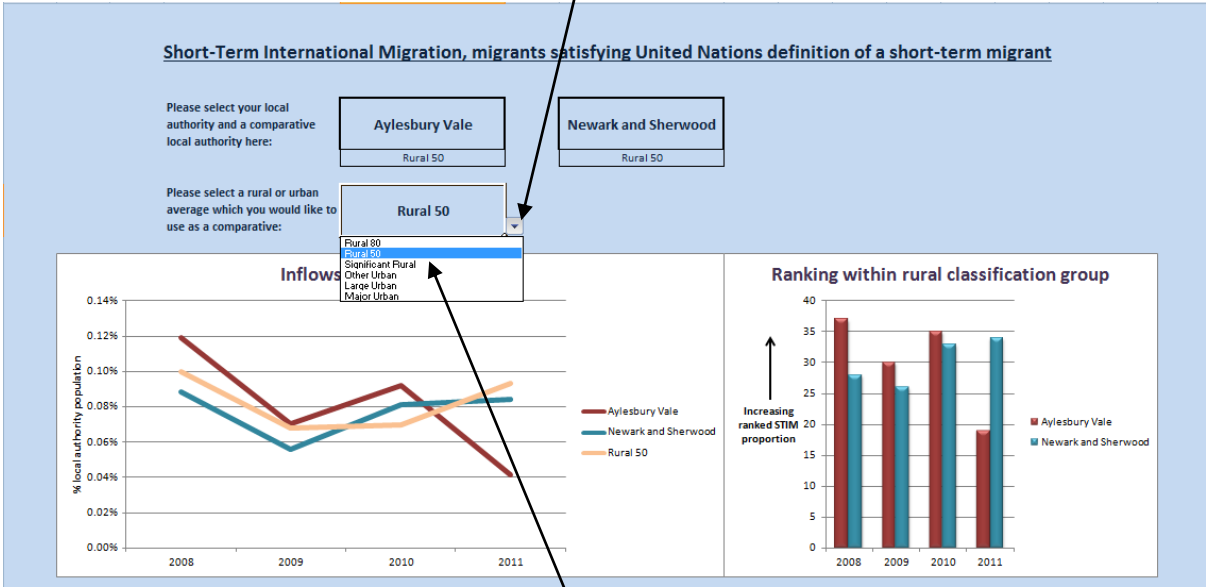
Migration is a hot topic. With this in mind, the following analysis takes a look at short-term international migration at a local authority level.

To use the analysis, please follow these simple steps.

The three option boxes allow the user to select two local authorities and an urban/rural average.



Using the mouse to select one of the options reveals a grey square with a blue triangle to the right of the option.



Clicking on the grey square then reveals the full list of options to select from.

The first analysis shows the total short-term international migration inflow (STIM) at local authority level. The second analysis shows the STIM inflow resulting from employment as the main reason for migration, and the third shows the STIM inflow resulting from study.

Against each of these line charts are bar graphs demonstrating the relative ranking within the relevant rural classification for the selected local authority.
