# NCRHC Pharmacy Project

- Training covered –
- Basic Life Support
- CPR including use of automated external defibrillator
- Bleeding and Wound Assessment
- Breathing assessment
- Moving and handling people and objects
- Mental Health First Aid
- Signposting to other health providers
- Public Health Messages





# NCRHC Pharmacy Project

- To build on services already provided at the community pharmacy and make best use of the whole pharmacy team
- Collaborative working with Lincolnshire Integrated Voluntary Emergency Services – LIVES
- Developed a bespoke training package for pharmacy staff
- We have delivered this to five rural pharmacies in pilot phase
- Holbeach, Ruskington, Heckington, Barrowbygate (Grantham), Kirton (Boston)





### Benefits

- Make use of an existing community resource
- Wider use of the skill sets already within the pharmacy staff team
- Improve understanding that the community pharmacy more than just a supplier of medicines
- Reduce journeys for rural populations
- Reduce workload for other health practitioners
- Make local pharmacy the community "health hub"

- Increased staff confidence in dealing with emergency situations
- Improved working relationship with local GP surgeries
- Two way referrals
- Assessment of kit and clinical space in the pharmacy
- National Context Digital Minor Illness Referral Service (DMIRS)
