


First homes completed 1988

Employed staff directly from 1993 (with 78 homes)


Now employs 8 staff




#### Resident Satisfaction Survey 2018

Percentage of tenants satisfied with the landlord's services overall




## **Tenant Satisfaction Survey 2018**




Net Promoter Score of 76
