# Secured £15million additional funding

Influenced the final Local Government Settlement 2023/24

- Swiftly responded to the provisional Local Government Announcement made in December 2023.
- Galvanised rural MPs with key messaging.
- Resulting in a £15million increase to the Rural Services Delivery Grant

Still more work to do and we won't be resting until rural local authorities get their fair share of government funding.
