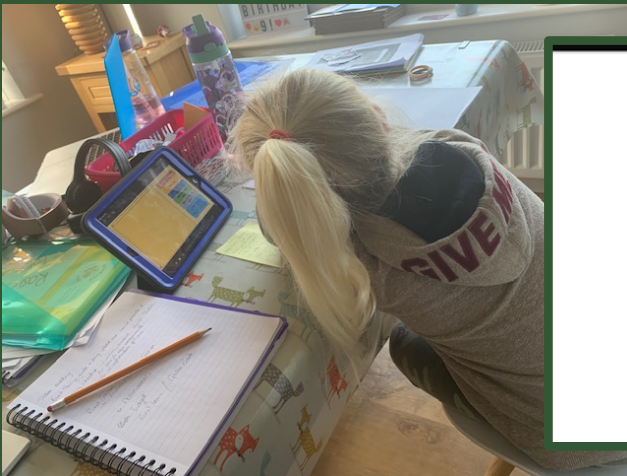

1. File your tax return online

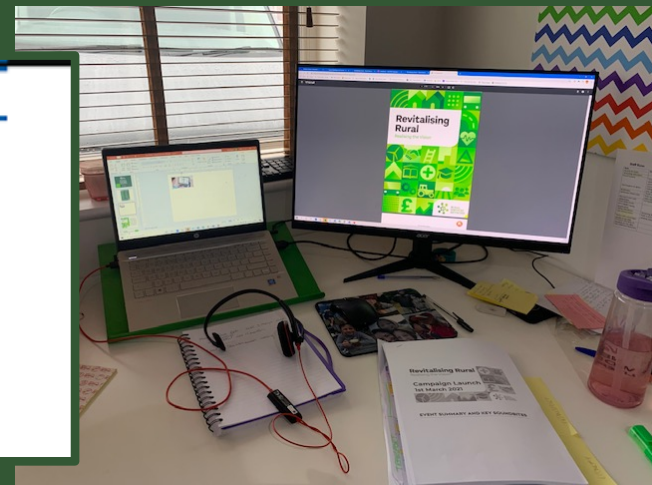
You can use the online service to:

- fill in and send your tax return to HM Revenue and Customs (HMRC)
- go back for a tax return you've already started
- check your details, view returns and print your tax calculation

If you're filing online for the first time

Before you can sign in you must:

- have your unique Taxpayer Reference (TRN) - you'll find this on the receipt that letter HMRC sent you
- read the online service (you can do this when you log in to a Government Service account)

The Rural Dimension

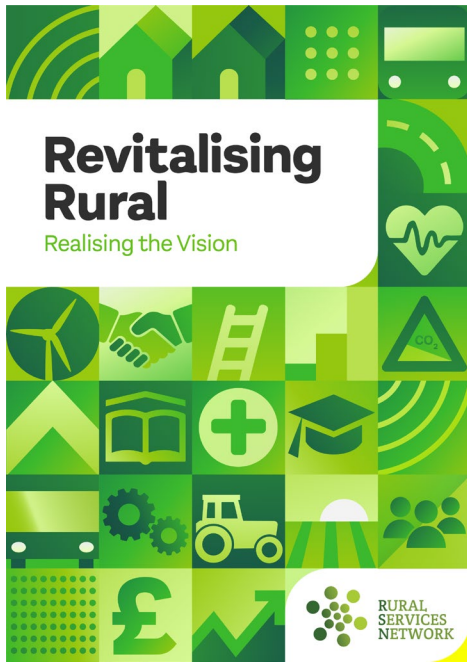
- Some 7% of rural premises (or 274,000 households and businesses) in England cannot access a decent fixed broadband connection of 10 Mbps
- There remain significant issues with mobile connectivity in rural premises. Some 30% of those in England are premises where it is not possible to make an indoor phone call on all four of the mobile networks
- Research from 2018 estimated that if rural based businesses could resolve their connectivity and other digital constraints, that would add a minimum of £12 billion annually in Gross Value Added to the UK economy
