- It is envisaged the Rural Services APPG will use data from this report to make recommendations to Government once the White Paper is published.










## **Suggested White Paper Recommendations**

- Increase funding in the Spending Review to meet rising costs and unmet need before 2023.
- Manage the transition from **residential to domiciliary care**.
- Fully assess the impact of new duties for self-funders.
- Enshrine in law a dedicated proportion of the new health and social care levy for care services.
- Ensure fair funding and equality of service across the country.
- Promotion of **rural proofing** for health toolkit
- Support the social care workforce in county and rural areas.
