Addressing the challenges

A rural unitary authority delivering Adult Social Care:

- Numbers of service users set to increase
- Budgets under significant pressure
- Recruitment and retention issues
- Continuity of care
- Constraints on accessing new income streams
- Little opportunity to generate income
- Having to manage within local authority system



Developing a solution

A business case to develop a new target operating model

- Implement a trading company
- Provide services to those who pay (direct payments)
- Locality working, extra care and day opportunities
- Multi disciplined care, provided around the user
- Taking the service to the user
- Better opportunities and fulfilment for staff
- Reducing the numbers of cross border placements
