

A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets – An analysis of number of local business units by employee number

The analysis of number of local business units by employee number shows the percentage of business units in a local authority area that employ people in the categories:

over 250 employees

50 to 249 employees

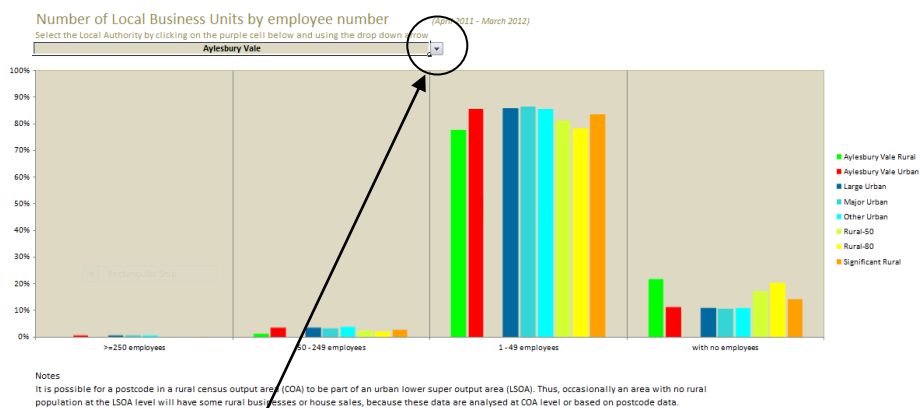
1 to 49 employees

with no employees

It also provides a comparison of businesses for the same categories within large urban, major urban, other urban, rural-50, rural-80, and significant rural areas.

The data was collected for the year April 2011 to March 2012 (kindly supplied by DEFRA).

To select the authority of interest, please follow these instructions:



On selecting the tan cell containing an authority name, a grey box with a blue arrow head appears. Clicking on the grey square will provide the list of authorities to select from. The full list can be seen by using the scroll bar to the side of the list.

Click on the option required for the analysis, and its data will be presented.
