

## A simple guide to RSN online Spreadsheets – Analysis of claimant counts

The analysis of claimant count spreadsheet provides a breakdown for each authority between rural and urban claimant counts based on Lower Super Output Areas. It also ranks each area type against all authorities and authorities of a similar urban/rural breakdown to allow relative comparisons.

The data was collected as of March 2012.
