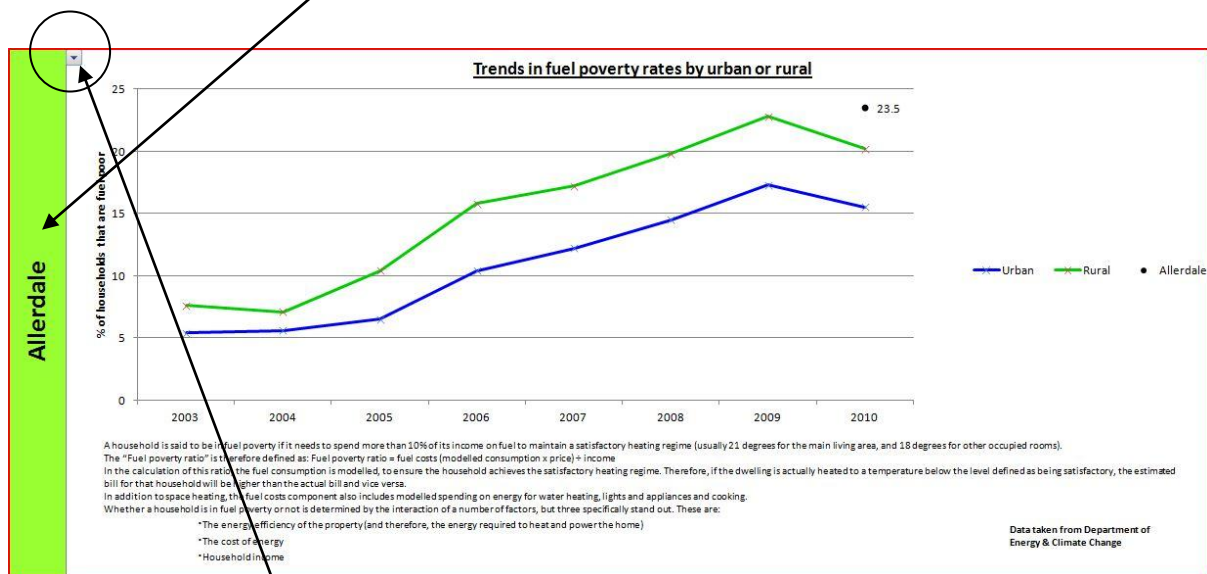


A simple guide to RSN online spreadsheets – Trends in fuel poverty rates

The 'Trends in fuel poverty rates by urban or rural' spreadsheet uses a drop down list to select the authority of interest. For the selected authority, the percentage of households that are fuel poor in the year 2010 is marked as a point on the graph for comparison against either the rural or urban average for that year.

To select the authority, please follow the instructions below:

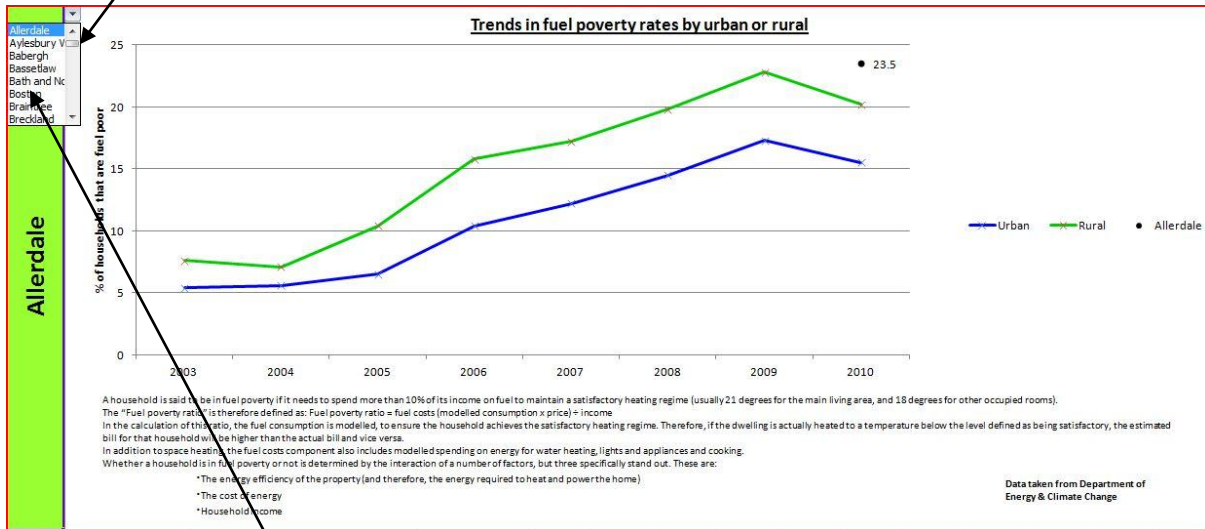
1st. Move the mouse pointer to the green highlighted cell containing an authority name, and select this cell.



2nd. Once the cell containing an authority name is selected, a small grey square with a blue arrow head will appear at the top right corner of the green cell.

Moving the mouse pointer across to this grey box, click again and the list of options drops down.

3rd. The full set of authorities on the drop down list can be viewed by using the scroll bar at the side of the list.



4th. Click on the authority name for which the 2010 fuel poverty rate is required.
